Time to Adoption: One Year or Less



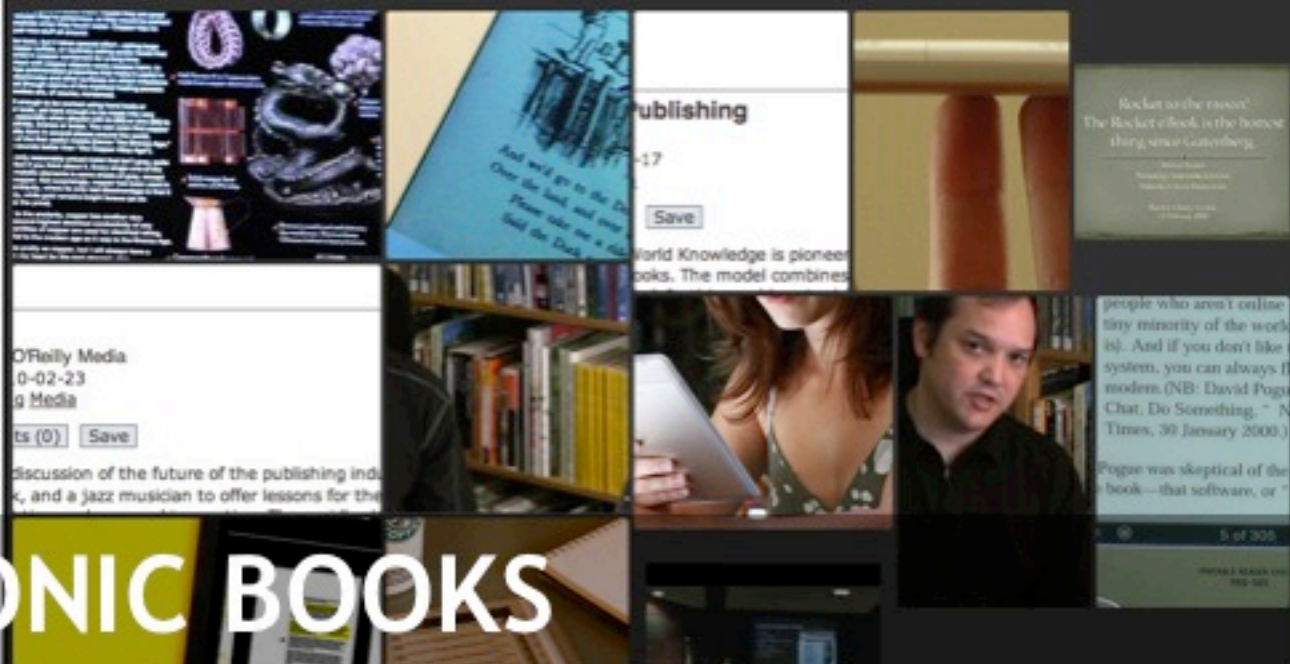
